100% Piquepoul de Pinet. Low-temperature fermentation. In tank on lees for three months. No malolactic fermentation.

Smells of apple and rhubarb candy, pear drops. Brightly primary, all sharp boiled sweeties and party-balloon fun. Super-young, a lemon-sherbet and candyfloss noisy funfair of a wine. Just the ticket for a massive platter of jalapeno poppers or prawns with sriracha and lime dressing. (Bit worried to see that Affordable Wine in Worcestershire are selling the 2013 for £8.49. I cannot see that nearly five years of age on this wine is going to do it any good at all.) (TC)
