50% Mourvèdre, 25% Syrah, 25% Grenache.

Charred and meaty and chocolatey – quite a gear change from the Montpeyroux tasted just before it. Much darker; grizzled tannins; tastes like a baked blueberry and chocolate tart with burnt edges. Then underneath, something rocky and mineral and shot through with wild mint. Needs food. Needs something deep and wild and slow-slow-cooked, fragrant with herbs and star anise and cinnamon, umami with mushrooms and game. (TC)
